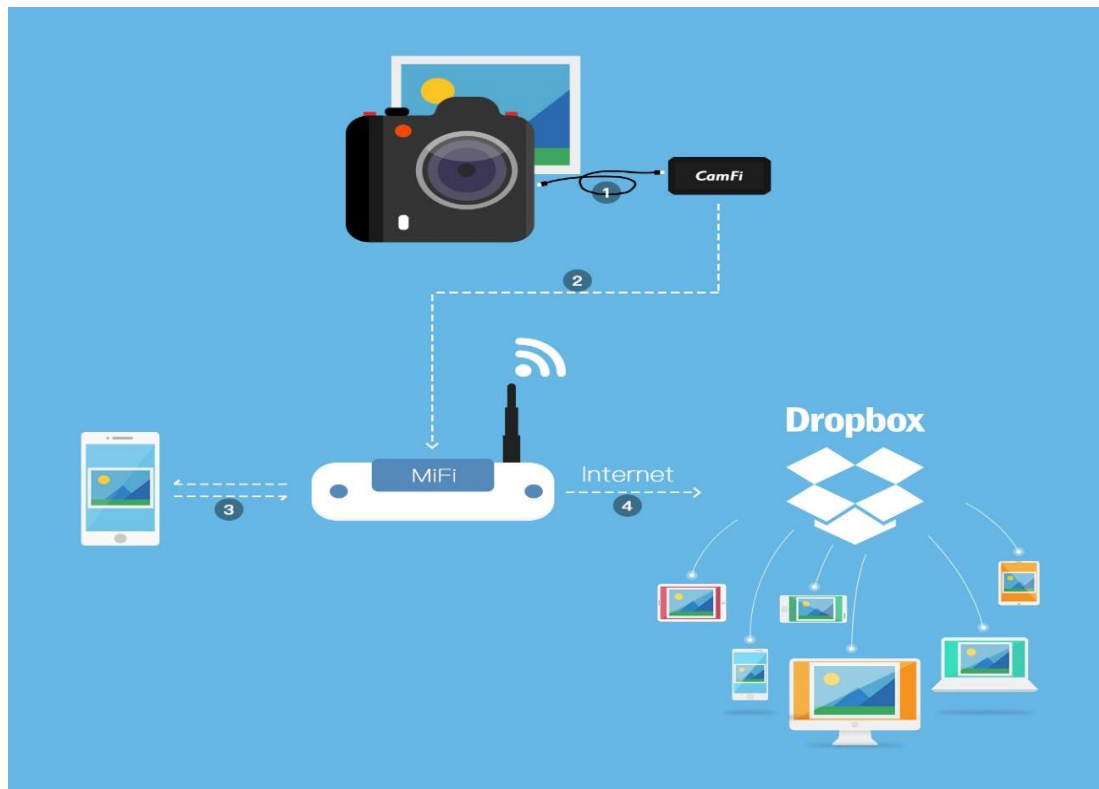
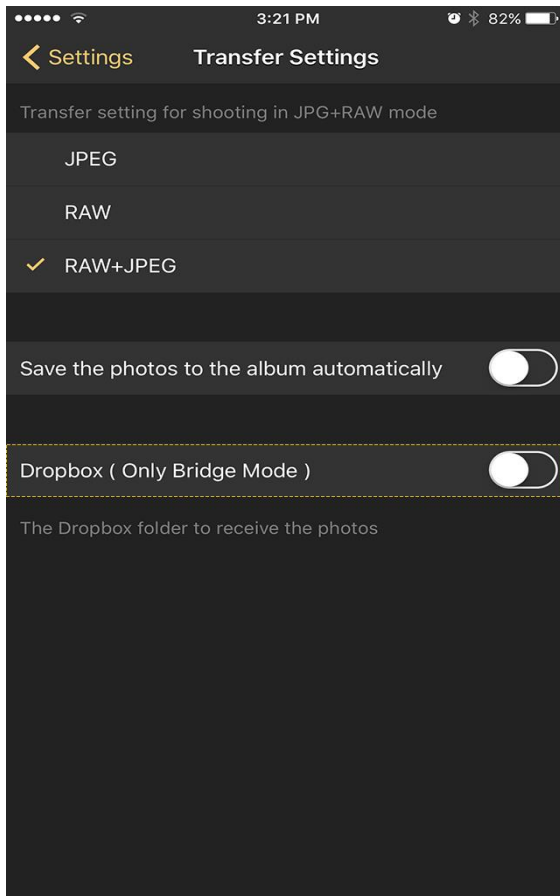


CamFi connects DSLR to Dropbox in real time

CamFi, the vendor of the wireless camera controller, announces a new version of an iOS app, which can transmit photos to Dropbox, while the photographer is shooting in real time. It is especially useful for reporters, who like to send photos to the newspaper office as soon as possible.



To send the photos over the internet, it needs a MiFi (or another phone) as a hot spot. When the CamFi connects to the MiFi with the bridge mode, the user can connect to the internet and use the CamFi at the same time. The image data from the camera will be sent to CamFi with a USB cable, at first. CamFi will transmit the data to the phone via Wi-Fi. Then, the phone will send the data to Dropbox via MiFi network. After that, Dropbox will sync these photos across all of the client' s devices.



The Dropbox feature can be also applied for Windows. It only needs install of a Dropbox Windows client and set the path of the receiving folder of CamFi to the Dropbox sync folder. The version for android and Mac will be released in a few days.
